



Bucket List Christmas in Lapland with Northern Lights

This 4-night Lapland escape is the ultimate festive bucket list experience. It combines all the highlights of a Christmas adventure — husky sledding, reindeer encounters, snowmobiling, and a private family meeting with Santa — with the added wonder of hunting for the Northern Lights under the Arctic night sky.

Location

The resort is located in the heart of Finnish Lapland, on the banks of the Muonio River at the Swedish border. Surrounded by untouched wilderness, it offers an authentic Arctic base with direct access to huskies, reindeer, and snowmobile trails. Family-run for decades, the resort combines traditional Lapland hospitality with unforgettable wilderness experiences.

Its riverside setting provides both tranquillity and dramatic scenery, and with almost no light pollution, the dark skies are perfect for northern lights viewing. The transfer from Kittilä Airport takes around one hour, making the resort easily accessible while still feeling wonderfully remote.

Day 1

Arrival in Lapland

Your Arctic adventure begins with a transfer from Kittilä Airport to your resort. On arrival, you check in and get settled into your cosy accommodation. Depending on your arrival time, you will be fitted with your thermal winter clothing either this evening or the following morning, ensuring you stay snug and warm throughout your stay. The first evening is all about relaxing, enjoying your surroundings, and soaking in the excitement of being in Lapland. Dinner is served in the restaurant, where you can sample hearty Nordic dishes and prepare for the adventures ahead.



Day 2

Husky Safari & Reindeer Experience

Husky Safari

The most sought-after experience in Lapland is to ride with the huskies, and it's easy to see why. After a short introduction to the route and safety instructions, you set off into the forest for a 1.5-hour adventure. Imagine yourself gliding through snowy trees, surrounded by silence and crisp winter air, as your eager huskies run with boundless energy.

In this package, the sled is driven by professional handlers, leaving you free to sit back, relax, and take in the beauty of the wilderness. Each family enjoys their own sledge, making the ride even more personal and comfortable. The combination of speed, scenery, and the enthusiasm of the dogs creates a truly unforgettable Arctic memory.

Reindeer Experience

Step into the world of Lapland's most traditional animals. You'll meet a reindeer herder and learn about the Sámi culture and centuries-old practices of reindeer husbandry. Try your hand at throwing the suopunki, a traditional lasso, before climbing into a sleigh for a short, gentle ride through the forest. The rhythmic pace of the reindeer and the snowy silence create a timeless atmosphere. This is more than just an activity – it's a glimpse into Lapland's heritage.





Day 3

Snowmobiling Adventure and Free Time in the Snow

Snowmobiling

After breakfast, it's time to start your engines and head out on snowmobiles. Following a safety briefing and driving instructions, you'll set off across frozen lakes and through pine forests draped in snow. The ride is thrilling yet peaceful, as you speed over open landscapes and wind through narrow forest tracks, soaking up the beauty of the Arctic wilderness. This is the perfect balance of adventure and exploration, offering a completely different perspective of Lapland.

Free time

This afternoon you will get to enjoy the Arctic at your own pace, making the most of the complimentary equipment provided by the resort. You might choose to strap on snowshoes and explore the nearby forest trails in peaceful silence, or glide along groomed tracks on cross-country skis as you take in the wintry scenery.

For something more playful, you can grab a toboggan and race down snowy slopes, or try out a traditional Finnish kick sled, sliding effortlessly across the snow and ice. These self-guided activities give you the freedom to explore and have fun in your own way, surrounded by the magic of Lapland's wilderness.



Day 4

Magical meeting with Santa & Aurora Experience

Santa

The highlight of any Christmas journey is a magical meeting with Santa himself. You and your family will visit him privately in his Lapland home, creating memories that last a lifetime. While waiting for your turn, there's plenty to keep everyone entertained with snowfun activities – try cross-country skiing, a friendly game of snow football, or let the children ride mini skidoos. The experience blends festive joy with outdoor fun, ensuring a day filled with smiles.

The Aurora Experience

This evening you'll head out into the stillness of the Arctic night for a guided Aurora experience. Away from artificial lights, you watch the dark sky come alive with stars, the moon, and – with luck – the Northern Lights. Even if the auroras remain elusive, the atmosphere of the silent, snowy landscape by night makes this a magical experience in its own right.



Day 5

Departure from Lapland

After breakfast, there's time to enjoy the wintry surroundings one last time. Lunch is included before your transfer back to Kittilä Airport. As you depart, you'll carry with you the magic of Lapland – the huskies, the reindeer, the thrill of snowmobiling, and, of course, memories of meeting Santa in his snowy home.

Arctic Glass Suite

The Arctic Glass Suites sit by the river, just a short stroll from the main building. Designed with floor-to-ceiling windows, they open directly to the vast Arctic sky, offering uninterrupted views of stars and, with luck, the Northern Lights. After a day of adventures, you can unwind in your own private sauna and watch the frozen wilderness from the warmth of your room.

- Living area with dining table
- Private sauna for relaxation

Standard room

Standard Rooms offer a simple, comfortable base for your Arctic adventures. Located in the main hotel building, they provide everything you need for a cosy stay after a day in the wilderness. Warm, wood-accented interiors reflect the natural surroundings, creating a welcoming place to rest.

The rooms sleep up to four people, with twin beds plus either a single or bunk beds, making them a great option for families. Each has an ensuite bathroom with shower.
